ALBRIGHT COLLEGE & Bucks County Community College DUAL ADMISSIONS & CORE-TO-CORE INTENT FORM

Albright College and Bucks County Community College (Bucks) have entered into a Dual Admissions Agreement so that students admitted into an Associate of Arts (A.A.) program at Bucks may be admitted into a Bachelor's Degree program at Albright College on the condition that they:

- have completed and submitted this Dual Admissions Intent Form before their final term begins;
- graduate from Bucks with an Associate in Arts (A.A.) Degree; and,
- satisfy all Albright College transfer admission requirements.

ADVANTAGES:

- While enrolled at Bucks, full-time Dual Admissions students may take one course per year at Albright College with the tuition waived (maximum of 3 courses lifetime).
- Albright's Application Fee is waived for Dual Admissions candidates (save \$25.00).
- Core-to-Core Transfer Agreement: Albright College agrees to accept the general education requirements that Bucks students must complete for their A.A. Degree. Under this Agreement, Bucks general education requirements will meet all core (General Studies) requirements for graduation from Albright, except: Bucks students must complete up to 3 foreign language (native speaker exempt) and 1 interdisciplinary study course to complete Albright's General Education requirement.
- All Bucks courses with passing grades (A, B, C, D) will transfer to Albright College.
- Full-time students entering Albright with third year (junior) status will be able to complete a
 Bachelor's Degree within four regular terms (spring and fall semesters) in a parallel program,
 provided the student completes the appropriate Associate Degree program at Bucks and
 completes the appropriate sequence of courses at Albright.
- Merit scholarships are available to Dual Admissions graduates from Bucks who enroll as fulltime day students at Albright College (enrolled in 3 or more courses per semester), and whose final Bucks grade point average is a 3.0 or higher.
- Part-time day students who take two Albright courses per semester will receive a \$400 per year scholarship (\$200 per semester).
- Students in Albright's Evening Accelerated Degree Completion Program are not eligible for any merit scholarships since the tuition rate is already discounted. However, a \$2,500.00 Partnership Scholarship will be awarded to any Bucks graduate of the Associate in Arts Program upon entering Albright's Accelerated Degree Completion Program. With a GPA of 3.7 or above, the scholarship amount increases to \$3,200.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

Merit Scholarships are available to Dual Admissions graduates from Bucks who enroll as full-time students. On average, a transfer student could receive a scholarship of:

- \$20,000 with a GPA of 3.8 or higher
- \$17,500 with a GPA of 3.6 to 3.79
- \$ 12,500 with a GPA of 3.4 to 3.59
- \$ 10,000 with a GPA of 3.2 to 3.39
- \$5,000 \$7500 with a GPA of 3.0 to 3.19

FINANCIAL AID: Aid will be awarded to Dual Admissions students on the same basis as all Albright College students. They will have equal access to Albright College grants, as well as all State and Federal financial aid programs.
