Students who have completed the above courses have met 19 of the 24 science credits needed for the RN to BSN & RN to MSN Majors at the University of Delaware. Total science requirements include a minimum of one course in each of these categories: Biology, Chemistry, Microbiology, Anatomy & Physiology, and Nutrition. If the total number of credits is still less than 24, students may choose courses from any of the 5 science categories. Suggested BCCC courses include two of: BIOL101, BIOL102, CHEM102.

The remaining non-nursing support courses are as follows:

Statistics 200 level or equivalent/ 3 credits (BCCC MATH115)
Life Span Development /3 credits (BCCC PSYC181)
*Restricted Elective / 3 credits (BCCC AMSL or LITR)
Free Electives 15 credits (3 credits already met with COMM 350 at Bucks)

** Art, Art History, History, Philosophy, Music, Theater, Comparative Literature, Black American Studies, Economics, Political Science, Women's Studies, Foreign Language & Literature, Linguistics, English.*

Graduates from Bucks Community College's AA Nursing Program will receive 30 nursing credits for their successful completion of the registered nurse licensure exam. This matrix is to be used as an example of possible transfer credit. Official transfer credit is determined at time of application to the program. See the GPA requirements for each program as well.
