## Être, Avoir, Aller, Faire: Present Tense

These are four of the most important verbs in the French language.

All of these verbs are irregular and must be memorized.

<u>**Être**</u> – <u>To be</u>

**Je suis** (*I am*) **Nous sommes** (*We are*)

**Tu es** (You are [informal]) **Vous êtes** (You are [formal and plural])

Il /elle/on est (He/she/one is) Ils/elles sont (They are)

**Avoir** – To have

**J'ai** (I have, am having)

Nous avons (We have, are having)

**Tu as** (You have, are having [informal]) **Vous avez** (You have, are having [formal and plural])

Il/elle/on a (He/she/one has, is having)
Ils/elles ont (They have, are having)

Aller - To go

**Je vais** (I go, am going) **Nous allons** (We go, are going)

**Tu vas** (You go, are going) **Vous allez** (You go, are going [formal/plural])

Il/elle/on va (He/she/one goes, is going) Ils/elles vont (They go, are going)

**Faire** – To make/to do

**Je fais** (*I make*, am making/do/doing) **Nous faisons** (We make, are making/doing)

**Tu fais** (You make, are making/doing **Vous faites** (You make, are making/doing

[informal]) [formal/plural])

Il /elle/on fait (He/she/one makes, is making)

Ils/elles font (They make, are making/doing)
