

# Spanish Regular Verbs – Present Tense

## *El Presente*

- To form any tense in the Spanish language, the end of the verb must be changed to agree with the subject that is performing the action of the verb.
  - This process of changing verbs to agree with the subject is called **conjugation**.
- The present tense is used to talk about things that are currently happening.
- Steps to conjugate regular -AR, -ER, or -IR verbs in the present tense:
  1. Identify the infinitive form of the verb.
  2. Drop the -AR, -ER, or -IR ending from the infinitive form of the verb.
  3. Add the appropriate ending (that corresponds to *who* is performing the action).

-AR VERBS (1 <sup>st</sup> conjugation)			
yo	-o	nosotros	-amos
tú	-as	vosotros	-áis
él/ella/ usted	-a	ellos/ellas/ ustedes	-an

hablar- <i>to speak</i>	
yo hablo – <i>I speak</i>	nosotros <b>hablamos</b> – <i>We speak</i>
tú hablas – <i>You speak</i>	vosotros <b>habláis</b> – <i>You (pl.) speak</i>
él/ella/usted habla – <i>He/she/you (formal) speaks</i>	ellos/ellas/ustedes <b>hablan</b> – <i>They/you (pl.) speak</i>

Examples:

- **¿Hablas español?**  
Do you speak Spanish?  
**Sí, hablo español pero ellos sólo hablan inglés.**  
Yes, I speak Spanish, but they only speak English.
- **Los bailarines profesionales bailan muy bien.**  
The professional dancers dance very well.

<b>-ER VERBS (2<sup>nd</sup> conjugation)</b>			
yo	<b>-o</b>	nosotros	<b>-emos</b>
tú	<b>-es</b>	vosotros	<b>-éis</b>
él/ella/ usted	<b>-e</b>	ellos/ellas/ ustedes	<b>-en</b>

comer- to eat	
yo como – <i>I eat</i>	nosotros comemos – <i>We eat</i>
tú comes - <i>You eat</i>	vosotros coméis - <i>You (pl.) eat</i>
él/ella/usted come – <i>He/she/you (formal) eats</i>	ellos/ellas/ustedes comen – <i>They/ you (pl.) eat</i>

*Examples:*

- Ella no come carne porque es vegetariana.**  
She doesn't eat meat because she is a vegetarian.
- Los jugadores corren mucho durante el partido de fútbol.**  
The players run a lot during the soccer game.

<b>-IR VERBS (3<sup>rd</sup> conjugation)</b>			
yo	<b>-o</b>	nosotros	<b>-imos</b>
tú	<b>-es</b>	vosotros	<b>-ís</b>
él/ella/ usted	<b>-e</b>	ellos/ellas/ ustedes	<b>-en</b>

escribir- to write	
yo escribo – <i>I write</i>	nosotros escribimos – <i>We write</i>
tú escribes – <i>You write</i>	vosotros escribís – <i>You (pl.) write</i>
él/ella/usted escribe – <i>He/she/you (formal) writes</i>	ellos/ellas/ustedes escriben – <i>They/ you (pl.) write</i>

*Examples:*

- Escribo cartas a mi familia que vive en Puerto Rico.**  
I write letters to my family that lives in Puerto Rico.
- Los testigos describen la escena del crimen.**  
The witnesses describe the scene of the crime.
