

Kids on Campus Behavior Choice Contract

Welcome to Kids on Campus! We are excited to have you with us this summer. Our administrative team, instructors, and assistants strive to be as accommodating as possible to camper needs, and we will provide whatever support is within our capacity. Our goal is to provide a safe and welcoming camp community, where all campers, camp staff, and College staff and students feel respected. The College has many staff who are in buildings working over the summer, and students are on campus taking summer classes. With this in mind, we require campers to follow the expectations and procedures listed below:

Individual Camper Behavior

- I will use kind and appropriate language while at camp.
 - Profanity (curse words) and threatening and/or hurtful language are not permitted. Discussion topics should be schoolappropriate.
 - I will keep my hands and feet to myself when not participating in appropriate camp activities.
 - Any type of purposeful physical violence is NOT accepted at Kids on Campus. I understand that touching someone in a way
 I know is harmful could result in dismissal from camp.
- I will not touch statues, hanging artwork, posters, other campers' belongings, and so on. Intentional damage to any college or camper property is unacceptable and will result in appropriate consequences.
- I will maintain a cooperative attitude and listen to my Instructor and Assistant when they give me directions.
- When I am moving through the hallways or elsewhere on campus, I will move carefully and keep my voice at a low level to respect the people who are working and learning.
 - I will run only when outside/in the gym playing an appropriate camp game, and I will stay within the boundaries given by camp staff. I will NOT run down the hill to the tent area. I will NOT move out of sight of my camp instructor and assistant.

Internet/Cell Phone Policies

- I understand that using the internet is a privilege, and I will only interact with school-appropriate content.
- I agree to keep my cell phone OFF and in my backpack at all times. I promise to ONLY use my cell phone in cases of extreme emergency to call my parents or guardians.
 - If I am not feeling well, I will ask the instructor to take me to the camp nurse. I understand that the camp nurse must be the person to contact my parents/guardians about picking me up from camp.

Safety/Other Procedures

- I will follow laws and campus safety regulations by not using or bringing any illegal substances and/or weapons to camp.
- I will leave expensive, valuable items at home.
- I will report any problems at camp or with anyone at camp to a camp staff member. This could be an Instructor, Assistant, the Camp Director, or Guidance Counselor. I will always be able to meet with someone to share my side of the story for any incident that is reported.

If a camper continuously breaks these rules, a parent/guardian will be called and required to immediately pick the camper up. It will be up to the Kids on Campus Administration to decide whether the camper will be allowed to return to camp.

Kids on Campus reserves the right to reassign your child to an age-appropriate camp if you deviated from the age categories during registration. Camp activities are designed for specific age groups and their developmental capabilities.
