Things To Consider

- Course work is completed online. Do you have regular and convenient access to an Internet connected device, preferably a laptop or desktop computer?
- The work required for successful completion of an online course is no less than that of a face-to-face course. Do you have 7-10 hours per week to spend on each 3 credit course you register for? Additional hours per week are required for condensed modular sessions.
- All eLearning courses are instructor led just as face-to-face courses are. Still, are you able to handle college-level work and study independently?
- Online courses offer convenience, not ease. Being comfortable with technology will ensure a positive learning experience.
- Online courses have specific start and end dates. Assignment schedules and due dates are determined by each instructor. Are you self-motivated and selfdisciplined? Are you able to keep yourself on-time and on-task?

You will have login access to Canvas approximately two weeks before classes begin. However, access to your online class will begin on the first day of classes and not before.


