What to Expect:

For **drop-in sessions**, no appointment is needed; however, please be sure to check the tutor availability for your specific course. The tutor will work with you for up to 30 minutes at a time, and then allow you to work on your own so that you can try to apply the concepts discussed. You may spend as long as you like in the Center, asking for assistance within the stated guidelines.

All **appointments** are 45 minutes long. You may have up to two sessions per day, provided there are at least 30 minutes between sessions. Second sessions are based on tutor availability.

Real-Time Online Appointments

Upon scheduling, you will receive an email to your **Bucks email address** with a link to the session.

The session will occur via Zoom. The platform includes options to chat/talk with your tutor, screen share, and annotate.

Phone Sessions (Appointments)

The tutor will call you using a blocked phone number, so be sure to review your personal settings prior to the start of the session. You will have the option to email materials ahead of time so you and the tutor can review the materials together.
