"Ask Me About My Hero" explores the significance and history of the Gold Star Family, a family that has lost an immediate family member who died while serving in the military, and the long-term impact and collateral damage on the families of fallen service members.

It explores Gold Star Family support groups and their function, purpose and goals, Memorials, Monuments, Testimonials, Tributes to fallen service members and their importance to Gold Star Families and Programs to support the Gold Star families.

Our story is told primarily through first person interviews with Gold Star Family Members, Service members who served with their fallen brothers and sisters in arms, Military personnel, Historian's and Gold Family Supporters. We're also going to explore several commonalities Gold Star Families experience conflict to conflict, generation to generation and family to family.
